

- 7 Urban Design principles
- 8 Form & Architecture principles
- 'Context and innovation'





ENGLISH REFORMS - NPPF

 Chapter 12 Conserving and enhancing the historic environment

para 126 - 141

- Introduces 'significance' (126 131)
- 'Setting' (128, 129 & 132)
- 'Substantial public benefits' (133)
- Non-designated assets (135)
- 'Expertise' (128 &129)
- Need for new Guidance
- P(LB&CA)Act 1990
 still primary source






ENGLISH REFORMS – ERRA 2013

- New primary source
- S.60 'Heritage planning etc' + Schedule 17
- Removes CACs (Sch.17 s.12 &13)
- Amends 1990 Act re designations (1 July '13)

allows exclusion of curtilage blds, parts and features deemed without 'significance'. (Sch.17 - s.8)

- Extends Cert. of Immunity (S.6 A1 + Sch 17. 9)
- HPAs (26 A&B)
- National and local consent orders (26 C-G & 28)
- Cert. of Lawfulness (26 H-K)
- NB all amendments exclude Wales





NORTHERN IRELAND REFORMS

- 11 New Local Authorities
- Delegating HE management from April 2015
- 'Normalisation' process
- Given HAR and CO job cuts in England

SCOTTISH REFORMS

- Historic Environment (Amendment) (Scotland) Act 2011
- Amended:
 - The Historic Buildings and Ancient Monuments Act 1953;
 - The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979;
 - The Planning (Listed Buildings and Conversation Areas) (Scotland) Act 1997
- Technical and general 'tightening up' of protection
- consolidation
- Registers for Historic Gardens and Battlefields





SCOTTISH REFORMS

- Consolidation theme
- Proposed merger of Royal Commission on the Ancient & Historic Monuments of Scotland with Historic Scotland
- Proposal to review Scottish
 Historic Environment
 Policy (SHEPS)





WELSH REFORMS – LEGISLATION

- Heritage (Wales) Bill
 - Cadw workshops in 2012
 - consultation June-Oct 2013
- Consolidation rather than radical change
- AM Portfolio amendments
 - lost 'Housing, Regeneration and Heritage (Huw Lewis)
 - now Minister for Culture & Sport (John Griffiths)



WELSH REFORMS – POLICY

- Conservation Principles for Wales adopted
 - simplified version of EH's
- Historic Environment Strategy (May 2013)

- 'Heritage protection and sustainable


development'

- 'Economy'
- 'Partnership and delivery'
- Old Circulars still in place
 - 60/96 (Archaeology)
 - 61/96 (Historic Buildings)



WELSH REFORMS – GENERAL

- Proposed merger of Royal Commission on the Ancient & Historic Monuments of Wales with other agencies inc. Cadw
 - weak business case
 - opposed by National Assembly Committee
 - no longer a priority
 - indicative
