Born 15 July 1938 in Helsinki, Finland; Graduated in architecture and urban planning, the Polytechnic University of Helsinki (1966). International Architectural Conservation Course (ICCROM, 1971); University of York: Doctor in Philosophy (DPhil, 1986).

**Architectural Practice in Finland** until 1970: Design of residences, offices, and industrial buildings, as well as urban planning.

**ICCROM:** 1972-73: Coordinator to the Architectural Conservation Course; 1974-88: Course Director, Conservation Architect, and Chief of Sector of Architectural Conservation; 1988-1995: Assistant Director of ICCROM; 1995-1998 Assistant Director General of ICCROM; During all this period, responsible for international technical and advisory mission for ICCROM and UNESCO on the conservation and management of the built heritage. From 1982 to 1998, attendance of the World Heritage Committee sessions and related activities.

**ICOMOS:** 2000-2006: Advisor on the evaluation of World Heritage nominations, including international advisory mission on the assessment and management of World Heritage nominations and listed properties. From 1993 to 2001, President of ICOMOS International Training Committee (CIF)

**From 2006 till present:** Consultancy on the development of conservation master plans and management plans (e.g. Iran; Georgia, Eritrea, Azerbaijan). Advisor on the preparation of World Heritage nominations. Teaching in history and theory of conservation, planning and management of the built heritage.

**Publications:** some 300 publications, including:
