The morning sessions will cover:

Heritage and Design - Legislation, policy and guidance; Planning and design concepts; Understanding context and a Q & A

Design codes and Policies - Heritage, climate change, biodiversity; Positive planning for historic places (including housing, high streets); Heritage evidence base; Resources and Q & A.

The afternoon talks and tours will encompass the historic centre of Newark which is a Heritage Action Zone and has an ongoing conservation project at Newark Castle.

Dave is Managing Director and partner of Urban Vision Enterprise CIC and a Director/Partner of D2H Land Planning Development. He has extensive experience of developing and delivering training on planning, design, placemaking, neighbourhood plans, heritage-led regeneration and community engagement and consultation. Additionally he has been involved in preparation of a wide range of guidance and publications including parts of BS7913 (Guide to the Conservation of Historic Buildings) and the IHBC's Conservation Professional Practice Principles and competence descriptors.
