
ompleted in September 2023, the Belsay Awakes project by English Heritage was a significant conservation initiative aimed at revitalising the historic estate and gardens of Belsay Hall in Northumberland.

The project involved major conservation work to the hall and its roof, and the introduction of new visitor and education facilities, to include the Wild Man play area, and the adaptive reuse of the Coach House for new café. The project was supported by the National Lottery Heritage Fund and aimed to create a more inclusive and adventurous experience for visitors through the rejuvenation of the gardens with over 80,000 new plants and the enhancement of accessibility and community involvement.

The day enables participants to experience first hand the Charity's challenges and successful efforts to preserve and enhance Belsay's heritage for future generations.
