Low income, student and fee support

As a registered charity, good value and the affordability of the IHBC's services are a priority.

Applicants on especially low income, typically under £12,500, including students, may apply to get fees reduced by 75% or more. For example, if your annual income is under £12,500 and you are a student, trainee, or volunteer, you can expect to pay no more than £25 to join for your first year, subject to application and renewable annually. In special circumstances all fees can be covered, such as through our fee-free crisis support.
